

## ESSER 3 FUNDING

### Overview

The Harlan Community School District has been allocated \$1,451,851 in the third round of Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funding. Of these funds a minimum of 20% or \$290,370 must be reserved to address learning loss (summer school and other remediation).

The balance of \$1,161,481 can be spent not only to address learning loss but also for other ESSER allowable expenditures, including activities that are necessary to maintain the operation of and continuity of services in the local educational agencies and continuing to employ the existing staff of the local educational agency.
